

LCLA College Scholarship

Information Sheet

The Lane County Livestock Association (LCLA) announces the 2020 Lane Livestock Association Scholarship program. Under this program two (2) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors attending a Lane County, Oregon high school.

Program Guidelines and Priorities:

- A. Seeking graduating seniors pursuing a career in agriculture, agricultural operations, animal sciences, mechanic and repair technologies (relative to farm equipment).
- B. Applicants must plan to attend a two (2) year community college or four (4) year college or university.
- C. Scholarship funds will be paid during the month of September, 2020 directly to the college, not the student. The scholarship will be issued to the college or university upon receiving a certificate of enrollment for the fall semester/term, which includes the student ID number and Financial Aid Office address.
- D. Applicants must have the endorsement of their guidance counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- E. Official copy of high school transcript with at least a 2.5 GPA on a scale of 4.0.
- F. One (1) letter of recommendation
- G. No handwritten applications
- H. Application is due by **August 1, 2020**
